CCCS is a small charter school with 1 class of 25 students per grade level, grades K-8. CCCS offers prospective educators a special school environment where the educators are empowered to teach, the families are involved and supportive of our staff, and our colleagues are intrinsically invested in keeping our school a great place to be. This kindergarten teacher position has the opportunity to work with every child and to see them grow over the years.
